## **IJSA SUMMER PREVIEW SHOW** & IJSA Field Day - Lincoln, IL June 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>

The IJSA Simmental Preview Show will be held at the Logan County Fairgrounds in Lincoln, Illinois.

<u>Hotel Block</u>: A block of 20, 2-queen bed, non-smoking rooms are reserved at the Holiday Inn Express, 130 Olson Dr, Lincoln for \$94. Call 217/735-5800 prior to May 26th for reservations. Ask for the "Illinois Junior Simmental Association" Block.

<u>Advance Entries</u>: Advance entries can be made for \$25.00 per head by May 26th. Entries made on-site are \$45.00 per head. Advance entries are strongly recommended and can also be emailed with entry fee being turned in at show. Check in will be from 6:00-8:00 p.m. Saturday, June 2nd. All cattle must be checked in on Saturday. The show will be held beginning at 9 a.m. Sunday June 3rd. Awards will also be given to the Top 5 Purebred and Percentage heifers as well as the Champion and Reserve Steers and Cow Calf pairs. Champion and Reserve showmen will also receive awards.

#### IJSA SUMMER PREVIEW SHOW - General Rules – In accordance with AJSA

- 1. Eligible exhibitors must be 8 years of age on or before January 1, 2018 and may not have reached their 22<sup>nd</sup> birthday prior to January 1, 2018.
- 2. Owners of all animals shown must be a member of the Illinois Junior Simmental Association and 2018 dues must be paid prior to exhibition.
- 3. All animal registration certificates must verify ownership in a junior member's name or Farm name with junior as ASA approved authorized representative. All animals must have a registration certificate to show. The general expectation is that each animal will be shown in the individual animal competition classes by the owner (showmanship classes excluded). Exceptions can be granted by the IJSA Board or a majority opinion of the board members present at the show.
- 4. Cattle must have a legible tattoo that conforms to ASA records.
- 5. All animals must have a health paper. Health papers must meet state of Illinois Animal Health Requirement.
- 6. Animals must have been born after August 31, 2017, and prior to March 15, 2018, and be registered with the American Simmental Association. Steers will show by age.
- 7. Heifers ¾ blood SM and under are considered Low Percentage Heifers. Heifers greater than ¾ blood SM and higher are considered Simmentals. This is a change to match IL Beef Expo and IL State Fair rules. Steers recorded ½ SM or higher on the registration paper are eligible to show as Simmental steers. Percent CS is not considered for steers nor heifers.
- 8. Animals may begin arriving on fairgrounds Saturday June 2<sup>nd</sup>. All Simmental cattle must be on the fairgrounds by the time check in closes at 8 p.m. on Saturday. All on-site entries must be made during check in.
- 9. No alcohol is permitted at the Preview Show regardless of person's age.
- 10. No artificial filling of animals will be allowed. The addition of hair, hemp or any similar substance to any part of an animal is prohibited.
- 11. IJSA voted at their February, 2018 meeting to have a no fit show.
- 12. Wood chip bedding in the barn provided from previous year. If you want additional bedding in your stalls, you must bring your own wood chip or wood shavings. NO STRAW ALLOWED IN THE BARN. All manure must be removed from the barn before premium monies will be dispersed.
- 13. Cattle can remain in the barn overnight. If you choose to tie-out, you are responsible for clean up and removal of your bedding. Tie-outs must be given board approval before premium monies will be dispersed.
- 14. No cattle may leave the fairgrounds until the show is completed.

Animals may begin arriving on fairgrounds Saturday June 2<sup>nd</sup>. All Simmental cattle must be on the fairgrounds by 8:00 p.m. Saturday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> and checked in on Saturday. All on-site entries must be made during check in, which runs from 6 – 8 p.m. Saturday. Steers will show by age.
